Technologies / Support gained from KVK: He is always in contact with KVK scientists for any guidance in farming. Improved variety seeds of rice greengram and groundnut are being supplied through various demonstration programme of KVK. He is trained for integrated crop management in rice and pulses by KVK, Kendrapara. Horticulture scientist guided him for better maintenance of coconut orchard. He is guided by KVK scientist for choice of suitable variety and trellis methods of vegetable cultivation. For pisciculture he is given technical guidance for fingerling and fish production by KVK, Kendrapara.



Innovative practice adopted: Trellis material from damaged fishing nets and locally available bamboo is being used for vegetable cultivation. The bund area is utilized for vegetable cultivation. Production of fingerlings in a permanent tank constructed inside the farm pond to a corner side.

Assets created: Diesel pump, motor cycle, Pucca house, Coconut plant rider, Refrigerator

Linkage with other Government organization: He has very good linkage with Agriculture department, Horticulture, Fishery and veterinary department of the district.
